ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY STATEMENT

Roberts Radio Limited assembles and imports radio receivers and ancillary audio equipment and, as such, this policy statement covers all activities of the organisation whether directly or indirectly involved in the manufacture of its finished products. The materials used in manufacture range from metals, medium density fibre board (mdf), polymers, adhesives plus a variety of electronic components.

Our aim at Roberts is for the continuous improvements in Environmental Performance and, where possible, to prevent pollution and encourage recycling and therefore reduce landfill.

In particular:

- To meet or surpass current Environmental Legal requirements.
- To minimise waste through better utilisation of raw materials and use reusable or recyclable materials during the manufacturing process.
- To ensure that future manufacturing process and related service activities are given due environmental consideration.
- To ensure that any processes where environmental concerns exist, where practical, are eliminated. If this is not possible, to ensure that suitable and sufficient controls are introduced to minimise the potential risk.
- To continue to increase the % of on-site recycling of materials including cardboard, polythene, power cables, plastic, metal and glass to reduce landfill.
- To communicate this policy to customers and suppliers, to encourage their involvement and approval and to consider their conformity to this policy in our selection.
- To promote and encourage policy awareness amongst our employees and increase awareness with appropriate training.
- To review this Policy on an annual basis.
